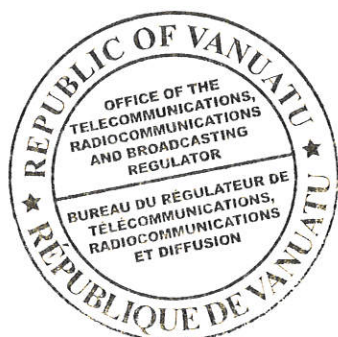

## **CONDITIONS**

1. This Amateur licence authorises the operation of an amateur station (s) in the Republic of Vanuatu.
2. The use of radio frequencies other than those indicated on this Licence is forbidden.
3. By the grant of this licence, the licensee is authorised to establish and operate amateur radios only at the geographical location and only on the frequency and at no more than the maximum power stated on the licence.
4. The use of the same frequency by the licensee at another geographical location is prohibited unless under a separate licence.
5. The validity of period of this licence is annual from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> December, and the licensee shall ensure that the licence renewal charge is paid to the office of the Regulator before the expired period to allow and enable the continuous operation after the current licence period lapses.
6. Failure to pay any licence fees and charges may result in the Regulator revoking this licence as allowed for in the Act.
7. These frequencies are, or may be, allocated for use by other services. Amateur operators must accept interference from, and must not cause interference to, such other services.

## **EQUIPMENTS**

1. All communications and equipment must conform to the regulations laid down by the International Telecommunications Union. The station will be subject to inspection by the Vanuatu Telecommunications Regulator or his representative.
